

ACTION REACTION

RULES: IDPA Rules

START POSITION:

4 to 6 shooters on the line - shooters will start in three different weapon positions for three different starts - pistol loaded to capacity holstered, then low ready, then pointed at target

SCENARIO:

This scenario re-creates a situation where a defender was confronted with a shotgun-wielding assailant and reacted from the low-ready position in .68 seconds. Will will try to match or beat that time.

PROCEDURE:

Upon buzzer, shooter will draw and fire one shot into either the down -0 or down -1 area of one target. Second buzzer, shooter shoots one shot from low ready, third buzzer shooter shoots one shot from being pointed at target. All times are then added for score. One target only - four to six shooters on the line. Two such stages are planned. **NOTE:** down -0 and down -1 area both count as down -0. Down -3 scores as down -1.

SCORING: Unlimited

ROUND COUNT: 3

TARGETS: 1

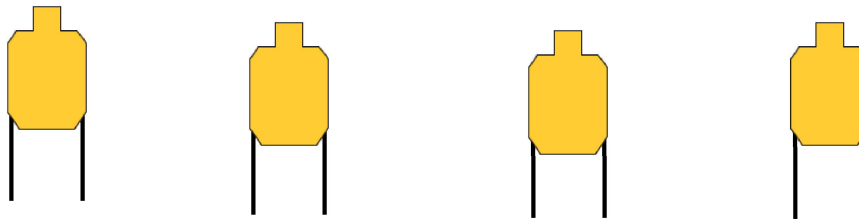
DISTANCE: 4 yards

SCORED HITS: 3 scored hits

PENALTIES: Miss

CONCEALMENT: No

NOTES: Down 0 and down 1 both count as down 0
