

Shotgun Run

RULES: IDPA Rules

START POSITION:

Low ready

SCENARIO:

You've got a lot of bad guys to shoot, and not a lot of rounds in your gun. Gonna have to reload on the fly.

PROCEDURE:

Shooter starts in the box with 4 rounds loaded into shotgun, including chambered round. Moves from start box to barrel while shooting the nearest 4 targets.

Reload as necessary, utilizing cover. Shoot next four targets and advance to the last barrel. Shoot the last 4 targets.

Squares represent knock-down diamond steel plates.

Empty posts represent clay holders.

Stage may not look exactly like this, depending on what we have in the containers. We will fill the stage with anywhere from 8-12 targets, in an interesting variety.
