RULES: IDPA Rules

START POSITION:

Shooter starts behind v-tac barricade with shotgun loaded to capacity, handgun loaded to capacity in holster.

SCENARIO:

Shooter must engage multiple targets from multiple positions with shotgun from behind v-tac barricade (15 yards from targets), then engage multiple targets with handgun from multiple positions from behind wall (25 yards from targets).

All targets are steel, either poppers (for shotgun if possible) or hangers (for pistol in any case, for all).

PROCEDURE:

Targets from each shooting position will be numbered 1-5. Shooter must score at least one hit (with shotgun) and two hits (with handgun) on each target. Shooter must engage each target from the numbered position on their barricade (that is, shooter engages target 1 from firing position 1, target 2 from firing position 2, etc). Shooter starts at v-tac barricade and engages first 5 targets with shotgun. Shooter then grounds shotgun and moves to wall barricade. Once at wall barricade, shooter draws pistol and engages second set of targets.

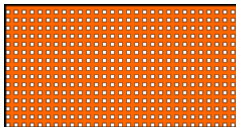

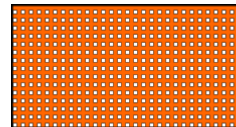
