## WHATS BEHIND DOOR NUMBER 1

RULES: IDPA Rules Created By: Cole Dillon

## START POSITION:

Shooter outside pistol shed, pistol holstered. Pistol will remain holstered until the shooter is in the first shooting box

## SCENARIO

On signal, shooter will move inside pistol shed and read instructions written on a piece of paper on the bench at the front of the pistol shed. Targets will be numbered 1-3 in the front, 1-3 in the rear - the paper will tell shooters in what order to engage them, i.e. 1-2-3, 3-2-1, 1-3-2, etc). Shooter will then move to the first shooting box and engage the first three targets in the prescribed order, knocking down each popper. Shooter will them move to the second shooting box and engage the second set of targets, and engage the second set of targets in the same order.

## PROCEDURE:

Score will be total time from buzzer until the final target falls. It is a 30 second penalty for using white light to read the instructions (red, blue, or green light is ok, and there is no penalty for using white light to engage the targets).

It is a 60 second penalty for shooting either set of targets out of order (that is, if they shoot the first set out of order, it is a 60 second penalty, and if they shoot the second set out of order, it is another 60 second penalty).

It is a 30 second penalty for engaging any target while not completely in the shooting box.
