MATCH INFORMATION AUGUST 16 2025 Urban Tactical Match

ARRIVE AT 7:00pm – plan on ending at midnight for our nighttime team exercise event.

We will use pistols and rifles this month. Also, if you have it, wear your full kit including body armor, medical gear, food and water sustainment, red light, weapon mounted lights (white lights OK), night vision OK, radio gear tuned to Family Radio Service (FRS Channel 8) frequency Simplex 467.5625. Don't worry if you don't have all of this equipment, we will work it out.

We will engage in four stages (attached to this web page). Three of these stages/exercises are coordinated as one inter-connected scenario involving an incident starting in your neighborhood's food storage area in a grid-down situation. You have teams of people protecting your neighborhood. The fourth stage is on the Pistol Shed and is just a fun exercise not connected to the others. We plan on running these stages concurrently, with minimal target resets so things should move along continuously.

See the stage diagrams attached at this web page for further details HOWEVER, all stages will involve some sort of discovery, some surprise, some development as you proceed, so the 'shooter-facing' stage diagram is not the complete picture. Be ready!

I would like to offer that if you don't feel you are ready from some or all of these types of activities, which involve live ammunition at night, this match may not be for you. BUT feel free to come as an observer if you wish – we are all learning, so don't be bashful about that.

With that in mind, I do have a need for people to volunteer for the following:

- a) We need up to four 'role players' who wish to take part on that side of the scene. Nothing too tricky, but should be lots of fun. Contact me via text or e-mail below
- b) We also need people to act as team leaders for teams of four to six people will assign on the night of the event
- c) One of the exercises involves moving in vehicle vehicles are not provided these will be personally owned vehicles if you wish to use them. Walking is allowed but could be up to half-mile.

Remember, our radio frequencies should be set to FRS Channel 8 (simplex freq. 467.5625) if you bring yours.

If you want to bring your own optics for the long-range sniper-spotter scenario these optics must be REMOVED from your weapon as we will be overlooking a live range.

Check weather before you come, and check range status right before you come as well.
