RULES: IDPA Rules

START POSITION:

Five shooters will stand at the firing line in a horizontal line facing the targets with pistols unloaded and all magazines containing 2 rounds.

SCENARIO:

In this stage we will practice shooting pistols precisely under pressure. An index card is roughly the same size as the area for the heart and medulla oblongata, two areas that will take down an attacker immediately. Shooters will have to shoot quickly with the added pressure of having to do a math problem to determine what target to shoot.

PROCEDURE:

RSO will instruct all shooters to load and make ready, then step to the first shooter on the line and call out an equation ex: "10-6" and then hit the timer with a par time of 4 sec. Upon the beep the first shooter will draw and take two shots at their card and then reholster their empty weapon. Then the RSO will move to the next shooter and call out another equation and hit the timer and so on. After all 5 shooters have shot, the RSO will move back to the first shooter in the line, instruct all shooters to load another mag and safely reholster and then move through the line again. After this second round of shooting completes all shooters will move back to 5yd and run through it all again.

SCORING: Limited

ROUND COUNT: 8

TARGETS: 4

DISTANCE: 3 and 5 Yards

SCORED HITS:

PENALTIES: Any shots after the par time will be counted as a miss. Shooting the wrong target counts as two misses.
